REGULATIONS FOR TRADE SHEEP SECTION

- 1. Sheep entered in the competition must be owned by the exhibitor.
- 2. The Judge/Committee has the right to reject any entry. Be mindful of infestations such as lice.
- 3. Sheep entered in Section 2 to be free of any residual coat or bare shorn.
- 4. Sheep with medullated fibre not eligible for Section 3.
- 5. The judge's decision shall be final.
- 6. Basis of judging all pens will be weighed and fat scored. Wool value will be assessed. Uniformity and type will be considered.
- 7. Sheep to remain penned for display until 4.30pm Saturday 18th May.
- 8. A waybill to be given to steward on arrival.
- 9. Points gained from placing from Section 1 classes 1 to 5 will be part of the merino aggregate trophy total.
